## PREFACE

This string trio is entirely based on a 4-part carol composed by Arnold Schoenberg in Los Angeles as the note example #77a on page 58 of his "Structural Functions of Harmony" (edited by Leonard Stein and first published 1954 by Ernest Benn Limited, London and Tonbridge, Kent). The chorale is transposed up a major whole-tone (frequency ratio 8 : 9) from C to D, tuned in classical 5-limit just intonation with pure thirds and perfect fifths, and performed at a very slow tempo - with some helpful ornamentations that serve to establish the non-tempered intonation. In large or medium-size acoustic spaces, the piece should best be performed with a subtle amplification, using three microphones placed closely above the instruments and an additional microphone which is placed about 6-8 feet above the middle of the triangle defined by the instruments. The four microphone signals are played back at low volume through two speakers (near-field or mid-field monitors) which are placed directly behind the violin and viola player, facing the opposite rear corner of the hall, so that their sound waves will cross each other above the audience.
